I will take feral cats to the clinic in humane cat traps. No pet carriers or cardboard boxes.	
I will ensure each trap is lined with newspaper (and newspaper only).	
I will ensure that trapped cats are fully and completely covered AT ALL TIMES.	
I will never leave a trap out unattended, for any reason or for any length of time.	
I will not trap past midnight, and I will only trap the night before my appointment.	
I will make sure that adult cats do not have any food after midnight the night before surgery.	
Kittens under 4 months will be fed a tablespoon of wet food at 6 a.m. the morning of surgery.	
I will not transport cats in the back of an open bed pickup truck, a sealed trunk or a sealed trailer.	
I agree that FixNation may contact me via email regarding my scheduled visit or other FixNation news. We protect your privacy and under no circumstances will your email be shared.	
I understand that the cat's right ear will be "eartipped" for spay/neuter identification purposes.	

By signing this application, I confirm that each cat I am trapping is a free-roaming, homeless cat to the best of my knowledge. I agree to humanely trap each cat and will adhere to all protocols set forth by FixNation.
